

# **Falcon Drama Boosters Meeting Minutes**

### **Agenda Items and Outcomes:**

- 1. Outstanding R&R issues to discuss before Parent Meeting**  
All the committee sign up sheets were ready, a method was in place to accept cast contracts and ticket orders. [Notes after the Parent Meeting: two committees were still in need of chairs, Carol will find chairs and let Kerri know who they are so she can update the website; Diane took the committee sheets and contracts and will give them to Cheryl H so that she can reach those parents who have not signed up for anything; the committee sheets will be given to the committee chairs ]
- 2. One Acts update**  
Concessions were purchased from a recent concert at the school  
Those kids who are performing in the daytime school showing of BATB need to bring in a letter from a parent to Mrs Jones indicating the reason for the absence from school, so that they can perform in the One Acts that night.
- 3. Film Fest update**  
There are only 2 entries and 1 judge, but it will take place as scheduled
- 4. State Theater Festival**  
Half hour segment of Pirates will be performed in show shirts with props  
The sign up package is due Wednesday (1/9). After the Festival receives the registration packet, Ms G will be sent the list of workshops from which the kids sign up.  
Ms G needs to have all the packets in see if staying the night will be possible (to see if there are enough chaperones). Chaperones will need to watch the volunteer video and have a background check performed.
- 5. Possible costume Donation to Montgomery College**  
It was decided that the boosters would make a donation of \$250 to the foundation that stores and takes care of costumes. Carol will find out the name and address and give that information to Diane so that she can make the donation. In the future we can find out if the school would be able to make such a contribution in lieu of renting costumes (a normal cost of a production that would ordinarily come out of ticket sales.) In this case, we have the funds and paying through boosters is expedient.

- 6. Summer Camp Program**  
Talk of camp was tabled for a later date. A small ad will be placed in the RnR program and information will remain on the website. In order to continue the camp, a booster adult will need to volunteer to take the lead on oversight (as this is a booster and not a school activity) and adequate student counselors will need to be assured.
- 7. Acting Workshop Update**  
There were 20 registered participants. Donna announced the workshop at the Parent Meeting and received one registration with check after the meeting. In addition, there were 3 other people who indicated that they will mail in the check and the registration. [Diane – when/if you receive those registrations, can you please let Kerri know to indicate on the website that the workshop is full?]
- 8. Additional item: Videography**  
Deborah had a sample contract for a videographer. The Pirates and other DVDs that folks have seen of Malcom Frazier's have been of such high quality that Deborah will work with him to iron out any remaining details (fee for watching a rehearsal before filming, having DVDs ready for sale at the second weekend or being responsible for distribution costs, we can distribute cast member dvds ...)
- 9. Additional item: generic t-shirts**  
Deborah is willing to accept presales orders for the generic t-shirts and will work with Kerri to get info online.
