Notes

The program is now more pages because of the advertising. The difference in cost should be reimbursed to the drama dept – boosters gets the advertising revenue, but the drama dept shouldn't have to pay for the extra pages.

We never worked out how funds would be distributed (like for the camp, work days...)

Going to Nationals is still the goal. Monies not going to individual costs – we be used to offset total costs.

Thespian points – have to maintain with 15 points per year. Thespians should send out reminder email to members.
