We encouraged Angie to use funds to take care of more expensive items from Cappies. We are willing to finance some of the Cappies tickets and possibly a bus to transport them to other activities.

Cheryl Heemstra asked us to coordinate the quick change rooms and dressing rooms. 2 people in quick change, one in each dressing room, boy and girls. Tracey will solicit from the group for a schedule.

Diane is planning to have tickets sold for Phantom from the cafeteria.

Melissa Odell has the plans set for the cast luncheon. We are planning for 117 people. She has plenty of help for the luncheon.

Kim Alfini has a story planned for the Capital and also in the Voice. We are willing to purchase the photo taken by the Voice photographer to have it run in the Capital. If that doesn't work out we will have another photographer come in to get it. Kim reported that she only had 4 scouts interested in a scout day. She will let any future scouts know.

Julie will send out the ticket order form to all of the parents of the kids so they are able to order tickets in advance.

There will be a school day assembly last period with one song. The cast will miss 3rd and 4th period.

We believe that the program is on track with Charlie. Tracey will email Alice to coordinate the complimentary tickets for the sponsors. Julie will email Lauren Bohman to have her make the board of sponsors.

Karen Embser is sending out the hospitality list this week for Hospitality table.

We believe the Ushers have been coordinated.

Ellen McGinn reports that she is fine for concessions. Thespians who are not in the show can help with the selling of concessions.

Falcon Film Fest has been organized for early December by Jake Lebowitz.

There will be 5 One Acts performed this year. Tuesday January 11th are One Acts. Tracey will give Angie Jose De la Mar's contact info, he said he would judge if asked.
