We are going to meet in January to preplan the Rock and Roll committees to have more of the volunteer slots planned out so that we can encourage every family to contribute time to their effort.

There is currently no theme selected for RnR, it will be decided after auditions. Student leaders are Tommy Minter, Henry Pazaryna, Rachel Truffer are Music Directors, Lucia Guarino Student Producer. Student Choreographer is being auditioned. The leadership will meet the week between Christmas and New Years to plan Rock and Roll. Auditions are ongoing this week and next. Over 300 students are signed up for auditions. All vocal auditions are videotaped for multiple music directors. Angie discussed the need for attendance for rehearsals and the maintenance of grades. She is keeping records of any attendance problems. They are encouraged to avoid conflicts with the rehearsal schedule and email Angie of any conflicts. We will have a committee lead meeting on 3rd to preplan the mandatory Rock and Roll parent mandatory meeting.

Julie will email Phil Vandemmia to get all of the email contacts for RnR band members.

We need to plan the concessions and tickets for One Acts. Julie and Ellen will handle concessions and Diane and Tracey can do tickets. Lauren Paxton will do the program. We are soliciting for judges currently, Jose De La Mar has confirmed to be a judge. We need four more judges. Only one One Act will be eligible to go to county because the others are all student written. We may not go to county if we have a conflict.

Falcon Film Fest has been tabled due to only one submission that will be shown during the One Acts.

We need to have our students train at CTA for tech crew, they will have to train during their "Once Upon a Mattress" training. We don't know when they need to go to train.

Broadneck would like us to audition earlier than usual for the Spring, Romeo and Juliet. We are trying to work with them to compromise with our Rock and Roll conflicts.

Juniors were encouraged to get monologues together for Talent in the Arts competition. They were asked to bring auditions to Thespian Meetings.

The Phantom DVD's are not going to be ready until after Christmas, due to a death in Catherine Thomas's family. The cast fee included the fee for one DVD. Angie thanked all of the parents for their support and read them a poem she wrote to commemorate Phantom. The elephant has been loaned to Huntingtown High School for their production of Phantom in March. We are planning to perform Masquerade for Cappies.

Thespians who are newly eligible can apply now to be recognized at the One Acts. Thespian applications are online.

Our Scholar Artist showcase will be updated under the direction of Elizabeth Embser.

Lisa Smith suggested we consider getting some Drama logo apparel. It was discussed that we would work on a design.
