Vice President Kirsten Mummert gave an overview of the upcoming season, with Atticus Boidy providing additional details.

### **Broadway Revue**

Atticus – A How To Video being produced with Nolan Marks to share with people auditioning. Great video for seniors to use for college admissions. For those singing, two videos will be required: One audio file and one with the student lip-syncing. There will be group numbers in addition to solos. If actors want to go for it with costuming or makeup to do transitions (different looks), then that can be coordinated. The administration can't provide anything in the way of costuming or makeup. No show fee will be charged for this. Each participant will get a free T-shirt. If there are any fundraising opportunities, money will go to the charity chosen by the Thespians. There will be a T-Shirt design and a poster design contest for the Broadway revue.

### **One-Act Play**

Atticus --The auditions will be live and the play (comedy) was written specifically for an online production.

### **Rock and Roll**

Kirsten – no details yet but we are hopeful that we will be able to do something in person. More details as that gets closer on the calendar, since we understand the performance situation will be constantly changing. Ms. Germanos added that there is a possibility that we could do RnR even

in April or May.

### **Various**

Improv Nights and SP Cares will be happening as part of the 20-21 season.

Thespians will meet next week and vote on officers and charity of choice. Burgers and Bands for Suicide Prevention and SPAN are both under consideration.

The RNR stage from last year is still on the stage at the high school, so it is a possibility that it could be used in some way. Ms. Germanos mentioned that the stage could be used as part of a tech crew club activity.

The goals this year are to involve as many students as possible and work with the students and administration to facilitate the complete slate of productions.

Information will be gathered on the Seniors and something done for them at the end of the year as a tribute, to be continued in subsequent years. This is something we learned from the pandemic.

There will be no cast fees for the revue or One Acts.
